

Start & Finish Location	 Start and finish location will be within a defined area, with sufficient space to allow runners to socially distance whilst waiting to start. Start and Finish to be separated if there will be overlap between starters and finishers. Competitors will be called up to the start line and must remain 2m apart where possible, or at least 1m if face coverings are worn. If a mass-start is used, consideration for seeded athlete positioning at the start line, i.e. expected fastest at the front to minimise close contact in early stages of the race. Participants required to arrive at the start line no earlier than 5-10 minutes prior to the actual start time, dependent upon whether there will be a race briefing there. If no briefing the time to be kept to a minimum. 	LOW

Parking	 Participants recommended to travel to the event by car and refrain from car sharing unless suitably within Government guidelines. Parking locations to be highlighted to runners prior to race day. 	LOW
Toilets and/or Changing Facilities (Male and Female)	 Participants are advised there are no toilet welfare or changing facilities for the race. Given local nature of the race, participants will be advised to use home facilities prior to setting off. OR Participants are advised toilets are available/provided, along with hand sanitiser which must be used outside the toilets before and after use. Face coverings must be worn at all times if queuing inside, and if outside a minimum 2 metre distance maintained, or 1 metre with face coverings worn. 	LOW
Medical emergency	 Notify a race marshal accordingly at one of 10 Marshall Points Participants must carry a face covering / buff for the purpose of protecting others if they become a casualty. 	LOW
Crowd gathering and spectators	Timing of runners crossing finish line shall be contactless. 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


